I am a hard working person who's always willing to help people who are in need and most specially I love arts. I am an artist and a coach or facilitator. I love facilitating the youth after me as I was taught

She made first contact with Khanya in 2021 and is still learning how to be a better activist. "I am using what I have learned to see how I help my community and organisation."
